- We will be learning how to join sentences using and.

MATHS

- We will continue practising number bonds for numbers up to 10/20.
- We will be learning to tell the time to the hour and half past the hour.
- We will be learning to draw the correct times on a clock face.
- We will be comparing, describing and measuring lengths, heights and weights.

SCIENCE
